

International Baccalaureate Diploma & Advanced Placement School of Distinction



- AHS is an International Baccalaureate institution.
 - The average acceptance rate for IB students into colleges or universities is
 22% higher than their peers
 - The acceptance rate for IB students into Ivy League institutions is between
 3-13 percentage points higher than their peers
 - <u>International Baccalaureate is not</u> offered at Innovation Academy or Cambridge High School
- AHS is an AP School of Distinction

AHS offers Advanced Placement opportunities in Humanities AND all STEM fields

AHS/Innovation Academy FAQ

- Band classes are <u>NOT</u> offered at Innovation Academy
- Traditional electives are <u>NOT</u> offered as a part of the curriculum at Innovation
 Academy
- Innovation Academy does <u>NOT</u> offer AP classes in the Humanities Innovation Academy is a STEM-only school.
- Alpharetta offers many of the same pathways and opportunities as Innovation
 Academy including healthcare, engineering, computer science, and much more!
- Students may <u>NOT</u> participate in band at AHS if they attend Innovation Academy
- Students must be enrolled in a band class at AHS in order to participate in marching band at Alpharetta.

AHS Band Academic Factoids

- The Marching Raider Band makes up a large percentage of all AP/IB students at AHS.
- We provide regular time and attention for students to maintain great academic standing, and the advantage of being in AHS band is that you have students that have experience in all parts of the academic and pathway opportunities of our school.
- Many of the previous AHS valedictorians and salutatorians are active AHS marching and concert band members (including the 2024 Valedictorian and 3rd place in the class of 2024!)
- Our passing rate during marching season (busiest time of year) is well over 98%! We have student to student tutorials, and band study days throughout the season.
- It is not uncommon to see students collaborating before Tuesday rehearsals to help each other get their homework completed!

Transition from middle school to AHS

- Over 2300 students served at AHS as compared to ~1200 at WBMS
- Students involved in band, particularly marching band, find that having a ready-made peer group prior to the start of their freshman year is immensely helpful in navigating the high school transition



- Colleges and Universities look for growth and leadership opportunities to differentiate students - many of which can be found in band!



How much does Marching Band practice?

The Raider Band follows the same standards and guidelines as all activities on campus, including all sports. We average 8 hours a week with our practice schedule. A full calendar of events can be found on our website.

But what does Marching Band Cost?

There are fees associated to band, which covers the cost of travel, food, extra staff members and clinicians, band camp expenses, props, as well as your uniform parts and enhancements. The marching band has monthly payment plans, and we can offer parents the opportunity to reduce your student dues if need be.

No child should choose to not be a part of Raider Band because of finances; we ALWAYS find a way to help families and make it work!




COLOR GUARD
